Each journal entry must be dated and include the page numbers you are summarizing. The summary should be at least 10 complete sentences per entry.

Example: June 8, 2013 p.2-10 or chapter 1

An AR test will also be taken for each book read! Students will have between August 15 and August 31 to take their AR test, once we return back to school.

The book selection is taken from the Indiana Department of Education.
