

IMPORTANT UPDATE

We are sad to report there are still many issues with unsafe driving in our parking lot. In an effort to help eliminate the problems, we are now asking that license plate numbers be reported of those not following our guidelines. Please contact the school office with the license plate number and/or a description of the vehicle jeopardizing the safety of our children. Names of those reporting violators will remain anonymous. Reported license plate numbers and/or descriptions will then be posted.

PARKING LOT SAFETY

MORNING:

- · Please have your child ready to exit ONLY on the right hand side of the car before you pull into the drop-off lane.
- There are five drop-off points designated by the cones. Drop off students ONLY at the cones.
- · You must pull up to the first cone available, not the one closest to the entrance.
- · For the system to work, pull up closely behind the car in front of you.
- · Drivers must NOT exit the vehicle while in the drop-off lane. If you need to escort your child, you MUST park in the lot, not in the drop-off lane. When escorting your child, please yield to oncoming traffic.
- There is NO passing of cars in the drop-off lane; safety first for children walking to the sidewalk. Vehicles will only be allowed on the left side of cones (drop-off lane).
- · Parking lot speed is 5 mph.
- · You MAY NOT turn left when exiting the lot.

AFTERNOON:

- · Park facing south with the first row beginning in the section closest to School Street.
- · Please pull straight, up to the yellow line, and no angles. Please be sure to park close to the car in front of you, leaving a walking path distance.
- · Drivers will exit their car to retrieve their child(ren) and IMMEDIATELY return to their car.
- · Cautiously exit the lot
- · You MAY NOT turn left when exiting the lot.
