Technology Updates

• Wi-Fi – The Wi-Fi for the school was only meant for 50 machines. SJE currently has about 500 machines running on the Wi-Fi. The new Wi-Fi would cost around \$3800.

- OSMO Is a program that could be used for multiple curriculums. It works with any I-pad and is interactive. 2 students work together on 1 I-pad. The most any class would need is 15 sets. The cost for 15 sets is \$2280.
- Board approved both the updated Wi-Fi and the OSMO sets.
